



WORKFORCE SKILL/EDUCATION LEVELS*



- Educational attainment of the adult population within the SCCC Labor Shed is relatively high with 85% of the population having completed high school and 35% having completed a college degree.*
- Current enrollment in college or graduate studies by residents within the SCCC Labor Shed is above the regional average, indicating a strong pipeline of future educated workers.*
- Programs at local community colleges in precision production, construction, mechanics, transportation, engineering technology and agricultural sciences provide a ready workforce for future businesses at the Santa Cruz Commerce Center. These programs have produced over 5,000 graduates in the past three years.*
- Nearly 89% of the City of Maricopa workforce has at least some college education with 46% having a bachelor's or graduate degree, and has a relatively high concentration of engineers.**
- The SCCC Labor Shed is quite similar to Maricopa County, but with a slightly higher share of workers in manufacturing and a slightly lower share in finance and professional services.*
- Overall, there are workers in a broad range of industries that could support increased economic diversification in the Ak-Chin Indian Community.*

Wages

The average weekly wage of Pinal County is \$759, among the lowest in Arizona and significantly lower than the national average of \$989/week.
